- 1. Explain what impacted you the most from Pastor Troy's message.
- 2. Who was instrumental in teaching you about Jesus, and how did you first begin to understand the importance of Jesus' death on the cross?

GROW

3. Read 1 Corinthians 15:1-11. What is Paul reminding the Corinthians about, and why is this such an important thing to remember?

4. How would you summarize the main points of the gospel in your own words? Describe the emotions that come to the surface when you read verses 3-5.

5. Why is it always important to include the resurrection when we discuss the gospel?

6. Who did Paul list that witnessed the resurrection of Jesus and why was this information critical in telling to the Corinthian church, and why is it just as important for us today?

7. What do you learn about God's grace from verses 9-11?

8. Read Luke 24:44-49. In verses 46-47, how does Jesus sum up the gospel message, and what words in this passage speak to the weightiness of the task? Why do we often have difficulty carrying out this assignment as individuals or as a church?

9. Read Acts 17:22-34. What method did Paul use when sharing the gospel, and how did he use the resurrection to talk about Jesus, and what was the result?

10. What would you say to someone who said, "it doesn't matter what you believe in as long as you have faith"? How does Paul's teaching about the resurrection in 1 Corinthians 15 contradict such thinking?

11. How does the gospel impact your life on a daily basis? Which aspect of the gospel are you most thankful and why?

12. Who do you know who needs to hear about God's grace today, and what will you do this week to share the Good News of Jesus?
