3. What did Paul say that looking forward to the resurrection should lead to, and why did he warn them about being deceived?

4.	Read 1 John 4:1-6. When it comes to the truth, why are false prophets and teachers not always easy to recognize? What is the first test we should place on any teaching?
5.	Read John 14:6. Why is it significant that Jesus called Himself "the truth"? How does that make Jesus distinct from any other religious figure in history?
6.	How would you counter someone who denied that Jesus actually came in the flesh?
7.	Read 1 Corinthians 2:12-14. How do these verses help us understand the nature of false teaching, and how does this passage emphasize the necessity of being an active part of God's church?

8.	Read 2 Timothy 4:1-5. Do you think Paul's warning to Timothy is still valid today? Why or why not? Based on this passage, what was the most important thing for Timothy to keep doing, and why might faithfully preaching the Word of God be a deterrent to false teachers?
9.	How does studying the Bible help you recognize and avoid false teaching? How should we respond when encountering false teaching?
