4.	Read 1 Corinthians 16:5-12. Paul includes a summary of his travel plans in these verses. Why does he send more mature Christians—like Timothy and Apollos—to visit the Corinthians? What does this illustrate about Paul's affection and care for these brothers and sisters?
5.	Paul instructed the Corinthians to help Timothy feel at home among them. Why is hospitality in the life of a church important? Describe different types of hospitality you have experienced at different churches.
6.	Read 1 Corinthians 16:13-24. What five instructions are given in verses 13 and 14? How do these instructions summarize much of the content from the first letter to the Corinthians?
7.	How do we ensure that all we do as Christians be done in love? What obstacles keep this from being the case sometimes, and what would you say it means to do everything with love?

8.	Paul talks about different leaders within the church. What does it mean to be subject to leadership in the church? How can you give recognition to your leaders and thank them for all they do?
