PHASE 1: MAY/JUNE/JULY

Key Focus: Returning to the Building

Mega Trends

- Touchless experience
- Constant sanitization
- Social distancing experience

Touchless Visitor Experience

- Worship-only experience in EP and Chaska
- Prop open all doors
- Floor markings to encourage social distancing
- No handouts
- No kiosks
- No offering plates
- No food or beverage sold or served
- No childcare or Grace Kids

Constant Sanitization

- Hand sanitizing stations
- Hand washing signs
- Fully sanitize between services
- Water fountains closed
- No building rentals

Social Distancing

- Required pre-registration for worship
- Add additional services if necessary
- Sick and high-risk encouraged to watch online
- Online-only chapel service (dedicated channel)
- Face masks encouraged
- Social distancing seating
- Choir suspended

PHASE 2: AUGUST/SEPTEMBER/OCTOBER

Key Focus: Welcoming Guests Back / Fall Launch

Mega Trends

- Expanded use
- Continued touchless experience
- Continued sanitization
- Compliant social distancing

Expanded Use of Facilities

- Managing increased attendance
- Resume Grace Latino services
- Pre-registration for nursery and Grace Kids
- Sanitizing classrooms, toys, etc.
- Possible Chapel reopening
- Weekly ministry programming resume
- Sunday classes resume
- Limited classrooms to allow social distancing
- Post-service prayer and support
- Sanitized interactive information kiosks
- Coffee and food service resumes
- Modified baptisms resume
- Modified communion resumes
- Modified weddings and funerals resume
- Modified visitation of sick and infirmed resume
- Modified building event rentals resume



PHASE 3: NOVEMBER/DECEMBER/JANUARY

Key Focus: Holiday and Seasonal Ministry

Mega Trends

- Expanded use and large group gatherings
- Continued touchless visitor experience
- Continued sanitization
- Compliant social distancing

Expanded Use of Facilities

- Prep for increased attendance
- Chapel reopening if not in phase 2
- Handouts and seatback inserts resume
- Suspend pre-registration requirement
- Adjusted special services
- Limited return of worship choir
- Emphasize generosity for those in need
- Limited building use by external parties

PHASE 4: FEBRUARY/MARCH/APRIL

Key Focus: Celebration

- Expanded use
- Continued touchless experience

- Spring and summer ministries (i.e. VBS, camps)
- Increased fellowship time between services
