

# Go Team FAQs



## What does the cost include?

The cost of Grace trips includes flights, visas (if needed), lodging, food, transportation and ministry expenses. The trip does not include vaccinations, airport meals or personal purchases.

## Do I need a passport? If so, when does it need to be good through?

If your trip is going to another country, you will need a passport that is valid six (6) months after the trip returns home. If you do not have a passport or you need to renew your passport visit [www.travel.state.gov/passport](http://www.travel.state.gov/passport). The process usually takes 4-6 weeks so start early.

## Can my kids go on a mission trip?

Most mission trips are open to kids who are 12-years-old and up; contact the trip leader if you have questions.

## What about vaccinations and travel medications??

Grace always suggests you visit a travel clinic before going on a mission trip. They are best equipped to give you advice on vaccinations for your specific trip.

## What about insurance?

You are responsible for your own health insurance while overseas. Grace will provide a supplementary insurance through FaithVentures Basic Plan. This insurance is supplementary and not a replacement for your own health insurance.

## What if I don't speak the language?

Our in-country representative will translate for you. Also, remember a smile and a hug will transcend language barriers!

## How do I pay for the trip?

We encourage all team members to raise a support team to pray for them while abroad and give financially to their team. You will receive a customized donation link for your trip. Learn more at [grace.church/build-a-support-team](http://grace.church/build-a-support-team).

## Are payments towards my mission trip tax deductible?

Yes, donations made online or by check are tax deductible. Be sure donations made by check are made to Grace Church — your name should not appear on the check.

## Does the mission trip deposit go towards my total fundraising goal?

Yes, most international mission trips have a \$300 non-refundable deposit due when you turn in your application. This \$300 goes towards your total fundraising goal.
