




MORAL CODE - NATURAL LAW

Rules and laws which uphold Gods ethical and moral standards.




Living a moral and honorable life, includes loving your neighbor, mercy, forgiveness, and charity.

Righteousness and justice are the foundation of your throne; steadfast love and faithfulness go before you.


BIBLICAL JUSTICE:
