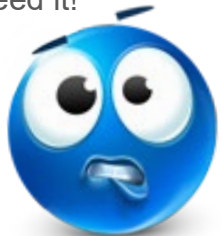

WHAT IS MY TESTIMONY?

Your testimony is your story! Many kids might say, “I made the most important decision to become a Christian, but I don’t know what to do next!”

Jesus commanded His followers (Christians) in Matthew 28:19 to go into the world and share the Gospel! One of the most personal ways we can do that is by sharing our story of how we became a part of God’s family.

In this book, you will find questions that will prompt you to think through your story. Everyone has a different story, so don’t feel like yours needs to be like your friend’s. This story is about when you heard the truth, the Gospel, and how God has changed your life. Honestly answer the following questions to help you get started. Ask your parent or leader for help if you need it!



1. What was your life like before you asked Jesus into it? Why did you think you needed to have Jesus in your life?

We want you to share your story with your small group, family, and friends! The more you share your story, the more comfortable you will be sharing.

Here is a fun acronym to help you remember to S.H.A.R.E.:

- S:** Share you are a Christian.
- H:** Happily invite them to church.
- A:** Ask if it’s okay to share your story.
- R:** Reveal how you became a Christian.
- E:** Explain how to become a Christian using your ABC of Salvation booklet.
