Matthew 7:1-6

¹ "Judge not, that you be not judged. ² For with the judgment you pronounce you will be judged, and with the measure you use it will be measured to you. ³ Why do you see the speck that is in your brother's eye, but do not notice the log that is in your own eye? ⁴ Or how can you say to your brother, 'Let me take the speck out of your eye,' when there is the log in your own eye? ⁵ You hypocrite, first take the log out of your own eye, and then you will see clearly to take the speck out of your brother's eye. ⁶ "Do not give dogs what is holy, and do not throw your pearls before pigs, lest they trample them underfoot and turn to attack you."

How can we avoid sinful judging?

- 1. By remembering our sinful judging will lead to our <u>judgment</u>.
- 2. By remembering to judge ourselves before we judge anyone else.
- 3. By remembering not to **over**-**simplify** this teaching.
