Philippians 2:14-16

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Philippians 2:14-16

¹⁴Do all things without grumbling or disputing, ¹⁵that you may be blameless and innocent, children of God without blemish in the midst of a crooked and twisted generation, among whom you shine as lights in the world, ¹⁶holding fast to the word of life, so that in the day of Christ I may be proud that I did not run in vain or labor in vain.

Four biblical cures for complaining:

1. God **commands** us to never **complain**. (Philippians 2:14)
2. God **commands** us to give thanks in every **circumstance**. (1 Thessalonians 5:18)
3. God **commands** us to **rejoice** always, especially in times of trial. (Philippians 4:4; James 1:2)
4. God **commands** us to **imitate** Jesus who never complained. (1 Peter 2:23)
