## Colossians 4:2-6

<sup>2</sup> Continue steadfastly in prayer, being watchful in it with thanksgiving. <sup>3</sup> At the same time, pray also for us, that God may open to us a door for the word, to declare the mystery of Christ, on account of which I am in prison— <sup>4</sup> that I may make it clear, which is how I ought to speak.

<sup>5</sup> Walk in wisdom toward outsiders, making the best use of the time.<sup>6</sup> Let your speech always be gracious, seasoned with salt, so that you may know how you ought to answer each person. Four Keys to Growing in the Disciplines of Prayer and Evangelism from Colossians 4:2-6:

1. Be sure to see prayer as warfare.

2. Be sure to see every situation through a Gospel lens.

3. Be sure to be <u>clear</u> with the Gospel.

4. Be sure you can answer hard questions.
