Romans 12:4-6

⁴ For as in one body we have many members, and the members do not all have the same function, ⁵ so we, though many, are one body in Christ, and individually members one of another. ⁶ Having gifts that differ according to the grace given to us, let us use them!

Eight truths about our spiritual gifts from 1 Corinthians 12-14:

1. God **determines** which gift(s) we do and do not **receive**.
2. **Different** people are given **different** opportunities for their spiritual gifts.

3. Ability and maturity are two different things.
4. We are to manage our gifts so that the entire church benefits.
5. God also gives us passions to help motivate us toward service.
6. Every gift must be cultivated if it is to be effective.
7. We must be willing to serve outside our area of gifting if there is a pressing need.
8. God has arranged the body in a way where every part is important to another.
