Romans 12:4-6

⁴ For as in one body we have many members, and the members do not all have the same function, ⁵ so we, though many, are one body in Christ, and individually members one of another. ⁶ Having gifts that differ according to the grace given to us, let us use them!

Eight truths about our spiritual gifts from 1 Corinthians 12-14:

- 1. God **<u>determines</u>** which gift(s) we do and do not <u>receive</u>.
- 2. <u>Different</u> people are given <u>different</u> opportunities for their spiritual gifts.

- 3. <u>Ability</u> and <u>maturity</u> are two different things.
- 4. We are to **manage** our gifts so that the **entire** church benefits.
- 5. God also gives us **passions** to help **motivate** us toward service.
- 6. Every **<u>gift</u>** must be <u>**cultivated**</u> if it is to be effective.
- 7. We must be **willing** to serve outside our area of gifting if there is a **pressing** need.
- 8. God has **arranged** the body in a way where **every** part is important to another.
