## Psalm 15

- <sup>1</sup>O Lord, who shall sojourn in your tent? Who shall dwell on your holy hill?
- <sup>2</sup>He who walks blamelessly and does what is right and speaks truth in his heart;
- <sup>3</sup> who does not slander with his tongue and does no evil to his neighbor, nor takes up a reproach against his friend;
- <sup>4</sup> in whose eyes a vile person is despised, but who honors those who fear the Lord; who swears to his own hurt and does not change;
- <sup>5</sup> who does not put out his money at interest and does not take a bribe against the innocent. He who does these things shall never be moved.

## Psalm 15 identifies six character traits God is looking for in His people. God expects us to:

1. Keep track of our <u>character</u>. (v2)

2. Keep track of our <u>speech</u>. (vv2-3)

3. Keep track of our <u>conduct</u>. (v3)

4. Keep track of our **values**. (v4)

5. Keep track of our **promises**. (v4)

6. Keep track of our handling of **money**. (v5)
