Psalm 8

- ¹ O Lord, our Lord, how majestic is your name in all the earth! You have set your glory above the heavens.
- ² Out of the mouth of babies and infants, you have established strength because of your foes, to still the enemy and the avenger.
- ³ When I look at your heavens, the work of your fingers, the moon and the stars, which you have set in place,
- ⁴ what is man that you are mindful of him, and the son of man that you care for him?
- ⁵ Yet you have made him a little lower than the heavenly beings and crowned him with glory and honor.
- ⁶ You have given him dominion over the works of your hands; you have put all things under his feet,
- ⁷ all sheep and oxen, and also the beasts of the field,
- ⁸ the birds of the heavens, and the fish of the sea, whatever passes along the paths of the seas.
- O Lord, our Lord, how majestic is your name in all the earth!

What is God saying to us from Psalm 8?

- 1. A <u>right</u> vision of God leads to a <u>right</u> understanding of self.
 - Image affects our value.

- 2. A <u>right</u> understanding of self leads to the <u>right</u> treatment of others.
 - Image affects our vision.
