Glenn and Kathy Kendall DAKAR/SENEGAL/WEST AFRICA



Ron and Diane Gullman AFRICA


Ron and Diane serve with the Anchor team, which equips Ethiopian churches toward mission and maturity through discipleship.






Julio and Sandra Herrera PERU








Daniel and Rosemary Henderson USA/WORLDWIDE

Patty McCain FLORIDA



Noe and Breanna Valverde MINNESOTA



Rob and Kathi Dyer SOUTH DAKOTA



Believers at Grace's first sister church, Bien Hoa Church, led by Rev. Cao Văn Hoàng, faithfully come before the Lord daily in prayer over the lost in their region and have planted three daughter churches. They have created materials to share the Gospel in this pandemic.

BUON ME THUOT CHURCH





One of the most difficult places to minister in Vietnam is in Buon Me Thuot along the former Ho Chi Minh Trail. In 1975, six missionaries gave their lives here for the cause of Christ. We now partner here with Buon Me Thuot Church, led by Rev. Huynh Kim Thoa, who has planted two daughter churches.

CAN THO CHURCH





In 2017 Grace Church helped fund the building of the Can Tho Church, in Can Tho, Vietnam, the capital city of the Mekong Delta region. This church hosts special evangelistic events, and they have planted three daughter churches.

DALAT CHURCH





Rev. Bui Phung leads Dalat Church, located in Dalat City in Lang Biang Highland, in southern central Vietnam. He preaches the Gospel truth in order that the light of Christ would shine brightly and the Holy Spirit would draw all men unto Himself through their church and two daughter churches.

DA NANG CHURCH





Rev. Nguyễn Thanh Hồng gives strong leadership to the Da Nang Church. In 2011 they celebrated their hundred-year anniversary as the first church planted in Vietnam. They have an ongoing church planting ministry with 11 daughter churches, with many coming to faith at evangelistic meetings.

HA LONG CHURCH





Ha Long Church became a sister church in 2018. Established in 2005, the church experienced persecution for over nine years, with some members walking away from their faith. Since then, they have experienced revival, expanded, and planted a church. Pray for Pastor Tan Ba Ngo as he leads this revitalized church of over 100 adults.

BIEN HOA CHURCH





Believers at Grace's first sister church, Bien Hoa Church, led by Rev. Cao Văn Hoàng, faithfully come before the Lord daily in prayer over the lost in their region and have planted three daughter churches. They have created materials to share the Gospel in this pandemic.

HANOI CHURCH





This sister church relationship began in 2001. During most of these years, Hanoi Church has been the only evangelical church in northern Vietnam. They celebrated their 100th anniversary in 2016. Pray for newly appointed pastor, Rev Pham Bá Hạnh, as he and his family build unity in the church.

KHA CANH CHURCH





In 1998 Grace Church established a sister church relationship with Kha Canh Church in Thai Binh, Vietnam. Rev. Bui Van Trieu has faithfully served here for many years amid various hardships and challenges.

NGUYEN TRI PHUONG CHURCH





Nguyen Tri Phuong Church, in Ho Chi Minh City, Vietnam, is a congregation of over 2,500 people. They are led by Rev Phạm Trọng Huy who strongly encourages everyone in the church to be salt and light to those around them. They have planted more than 10 daughter churches.

NHA TRANG CHURCH





Pastor Pham Sinh leads the Nha Trang Church, in the city of Nha Trang, Vietnam. On any given Sunday morning, more than 1,700 worship there, inspiring us with their consistent evangelistic outreaches and discipleship. They have planted two daughter churches.

PHUOC LONG CHURCH





Pastor Dieu D'rout and his family carry on the legacy begun by Mrs. Dang in Phuoc Long Church, in the Vietnam Highlands. After losing her husband and son by persecution, she led the church alone until her death in 1998. There are 47 daughter churches, with over 22,000 believers in this tribal area.

PHUONG HOA CHURCH





Grace's sister church relationship with Phoung Hoa Church, in Tam Ky, Vietnam, began in 2017. Rev. Ong Van Tin gives vision and leadership to a congregation actively involved in personal evangelism and evangelistic outreaches. They have planted two churches and regularly lead medical mission trips.

SISTER CHURCHES LATIN AMERICA AND THE CARIBBEAN

CALLAO CHURCH





In 1988, a sister church relationship was begun with Callao Church that has deepened into a relationship between believers joined together by their love for Jesus. Rev. Joaquin Alegre gives vision and leadership to this congregation. They have planted five sister churches.

FIRST BAPTIST CHURCH OF MOA



First Baptist Church of Moa, formerly known as Bethania Church, became a sister church in 2003. Despite many challenges, they have brought the Gospel from eastern Cuba to the west through church planting, growing cell groups, and evangelism.

They are in need of a pastor.


JESUS IS THE LIGHT OF THE WORLD CHURCH





Jesus Is the Light of the World Church holds high the cross of Christ in the heart of Baghdad, Iraq, with the cross boldly displayed on top of the building. In 2004, this became our first sister church in Iraq. Pastor Joseph Fransis leads this congregation.

KASR EL DOBARA CHURCH





Rev. Sameh Maurice heads the pastoral staff of Kasr El Dobara Church, our sister church in Cairo, Egypt. They boldly reach out every day to those around them with the truth of the Gospel of Christ and tangibly share His love.

KURDZMAN CHURCH



In 1990, Grace began a sister church relationship with the Kurdzman Church, located in the northern Iraqi city of Erbil. In recent months, many refugees have flooded into Erbil and the church ministers to these needy people daily. Pray for the Lord to bring a new pastor to this congregation.

MOSUL CHURCH



Formerly called Nineveh, Mosul, in northern Iraq, is a volatile city with great animosity toward Christians. Pastor Abu Karim passed away in 2016 after he and his family were forced to flee their home. The Mosul Church, needs our prayers in these uncertain times.


The Timothy Initiative (TTI)

TTI is a multiplying, church-planting movement led by David Nelms. Working with TTI's indigenous leaders, we are penetrating the most hard-to-reach places including Pakistan, Northern India, Nepal, Egypt, Myanmar, and Vietnam.



Reaching Unreached Nations (RUN)

Reaching Unreached Nations (RUN) has the goal "to bring the revelation of God and His kingdom to unreached people" by sharing the Gospel and establishing sustainable local churches. Together with leader Eric Watt, we are equipping and sending indigenous church planters in Middle East, North Africa, Central Asia, and China.



Twin Cities TTI

Twin Cities TTI is led by Pastor Steve Harrison alongside other church planters and ethnic leaders who train others to become disciple-makers ("Timothys"). Their prayer is to see disciple-making churches in immigrant communities accounting for 1 million people and 96 ethnic groups, 90% of whom are unchurched.

END2END (E2E) PARTNERSHIPS

End2End (E2E) Strategy

The local evangelical church is where life transformation happens and has the most effective relief and community development strategy. The End2End Strategy is for a church to be established for every 1,000 people in every neighborhood and village, covering every tribe, nation, and language for the glory of God. Gospel-advancing ministries have come together and see the number of people coming to Christ per church significantly increase and more places being reached in a shorter period of time and resources are being maximized: Believer, Body of Christ, and Bible.
