• Run from every temptation, knowing that one sin is enough to warrant infinite damnation. (Rom. 5:12-21; 1 Cor. 6:18-20; Rom. 13:14; Job 31:1)

Flee from sexual immorality. Every other sin a person commits is outside the body, but the sexually immoral person sins against his own body. Or do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit within you, whom you have from God? You are not your own, for you were bought with a price. So glorify God in your body." 1 Corinthians 6:18-20

• Guard yourself with godly friendships and gospel accountability. (Heb. 3:12-13; 10:24-25)

Take care, brothers, lest there be in any of you an evil, unbelieving heart, leading you to fall away from the living God. But exhort one another every day, as long as it is called "today," that none of you may be hardened by the deceitfulness of sin.
